QUESTION-1: What was the mission of Christ?

READ-1.03: John 10:10

DISCOVERY-1: CHRIST CAME TO:

- 1. Fulfill what Adam failed to do.
- 2. Destroy the works of Satan.
- 3. Restore what Adam lost.

QUESTION-2: What did Christ do as the Second Adam?

READ-2.01: Heb. 2:17-18; Heb. 4:15

READ-2.02: Phil. 2:8 READ-2.03: John 15:9-10

DISCOVERY-2: CHRIST DID WHAT ADAM FAILED TO DO BY:

1. Overcoming Satan's temptations.

- 2. Living a life of perfect obedience and service to God.
- 3. Maintaining an intimate connection with God.

QUESTION-3: How did Christ destroy the works of the devil?

READ-3.01: Rom. 6:23; John 19:16-24, 28-30; 2 Cor. 5:21

READ-3.02: Isa. 53:4-5; Matt. 8:16-17

READ-3.03: 1 Cor. 15:20-22; Col. 2:15,20

<u>DISCOVERY-3</u>: JESUS CHRIST FINISHED HIS WORK OF DESTROYING THE WORKS OF SATAN WHEN HE:

- 1. Dealt with the penalty for all sins by dying on the cross.
- 2. Dealt with the curse of sin by:
 - a. Dying to bring healing for our diseases.
 - b. Rising from the dead to conquer death.

QUESTION-4: What was the effect of Christ's finished work on man's separation from God?

READ-4.01: Eph. 1:7; Col. 2:13-14; 2 Cor. 5:19

READ-4.02: 1 John 4:9,10; Isa. 44:22

READ-4.03: Acts 10:43; John 3:16-18

DISCOVERY-4: BECAUSE OF THE FINISHED WORK OF JESUS CHRIST, WE CAN BE ASSURED OF THE FOLLOWING:

<u>The Cross</u> - When He died on the cross, Christ gained forgiveness for all sins – past, present and future. We are forgiven by God because of the blood of Jesus.

<u>The Resurrection</u> - when He rose from the dead, Christ gained eternal life for all who would believe.

<u>Restoration</u> - We are saved into God's Kingdom when we believe in Jesus Christ as our Savior and Lord.



UNDERSTAND THE FINISHED WORK OF CHRIST.

In order for me to be reconciled to God, I must know, understand and believe that:

- a. My sin has separated me from a holy and righteous God and I must realize that it is impossible for me in my sinful state to obey God's law.
- b. My loving heavenly Father wants me to come home to His Kingdom. The ministry of Jesus that revealed and demonstrated the grace and love of God is already finished.
- c. Because of the finished work of Christ, all of my sins have been forgiven and now I can understand and believe the goodness of God.

SUMMARY

Jesus Christ died on the cross to satisfy and maintain God's justice and to demonstrate God's unconditional love for sinners. Because Jesus paid for the penalty of all sins on the cross, once for all time, God forgave all our sins — past, present and future. We are restored to a right relationship with God — no longer considered as guilty and condemned — when we believe in Jesus Christ and accept Him as our Savior and Lord.
