DISCOVER

Every child who is born to the king or queen of England becomes a member of the royal family. However, before they can rule England, they go through an extensive training period. They don't train in order to become princes or princesses; they already are, simply by being born. They train so they can rule properly and effectively. The preparation of a monarch's children for their royal duties is long, arduous and painstaking. There is no easy path of preparation for future rulers.

When Christ calls you to be His disciple, it is an invitation for you to enter a life of growing, maturing, equipping and training for a glorious work here on earth and in the earth to come.

Death - He set me free from the power of sin.

Burial - He forgave my past, sinful life.

Resurrection - He gave me a new life.

3. Baptism represents my commitment to follow Jesus and serve His church.

MOVE TOWARD MY ROYAL DESTINY BY BECOMING A DISCIPLE OF CHRIST.

When I receive Jesus, I am also called to become His disciple, to follow Him, to learn from Him, to work for Him, and to be like Him. When I answer His call, God helps me to keep choosing Christ as my first priority in life until nothing on earth is more precious to me than my relationship with Him; until I am willing to lose everything – even my own life. For it is only by losing my life that I fulfill God's destiny for me of ruling with Him forever.

SUMMARY

God saved me for a grander purpose than merely avoiding eternal punishment. I was saved so I could be restored to God's original purpose for humankind – ruling earth. In the place of Adam, I now have Christ to rule with me. After my legal restoration to God's Kingdom, I am called to undergo a process of growth, maturity and equipping for my royal duties in this life and for eternity. The process involves increasing levels of commitment as my value system changes, until Jesus becomes my first priority in life, above all of the things of this world.
